Next Steps: Home-Group Study and/or Personal Discipleship Guide

Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!

Start with <u>Prayer</u> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.

READ THE TEXT - Mark 4:35-6:6a (or portions)

QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION & DISCUSSION:

- 1. How does fear creep in and keep the disciples of Jesus from walking and living by faith? Where does fear creep into our Christian communities today, keeping us from living by faith? How does Paul suggest that faith is most effectively expressed? (Gal. 5:6-7) How might that reality sometimes be uncomfortable and disruptive to us and our Christian communities?
- 2. Why does Jesus ask the man who had been freed from demons to stay among his own people? (5:17-20) What would be significant regarding this man's persisting presence in his own community?
- 3. As a ruler of the synagogue, what stands out to you regarding Jairus' approach to Jesus? How was his posture different from the other religious rulers of Jesus' day?
- 4. On the way to heal Jairus' daughter, Jesus is touched by a woman who has a disease. Compare the posture of the woman to the posture of Jairus. What do the woman and Jairus have in common? And what might have Jairus, as a synagogue ruler, learned about Jesus from this event?
- 5. Discuss the response of Jesus' own hometown, to his miracles, power, and authority. What questions did they ask, and how do their questions reveal the condition of their hearts? What amazed Jesus, and how did their response affect his ministry in their region? (6:1-6a)

QUESTIONS GUIDING SPIRITUAL FORMATION & APPLICATION:

- 1. How does this text challenge us to grow in a greater love for God?
- 2. How are we motivated to grow in a greater love for others?
- 3. How might Jesus be motivating us to apply some of the principles from this passage to our families, careers, communities, or churches?
- 4. How might Jesus be using us to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?
- 5. How can we pray for each other between now and next time?
