Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 4:6-13)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does the critiquing, criticizing, and judging of other Christian workers put us in danger of being prideful and puffed up? (vs. 6) 2. What are the dangers of looking at other ministries or churches and comparing ourselves to them? 3. Talk about the ways that pride is harmful to the body of Christ. How does pride work against unity and promote division within the body of Christ? 4. What postures or attitudes might be required of believers in order to keep from being shipwrecked by pride? Talk about specific words, phrases, actions or postures that demonstrate humility. 5. Explore verses 10-13 together, take note of postures and behaviors that Paul associates with the stewardship of the Body of Christ. <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church? 4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
