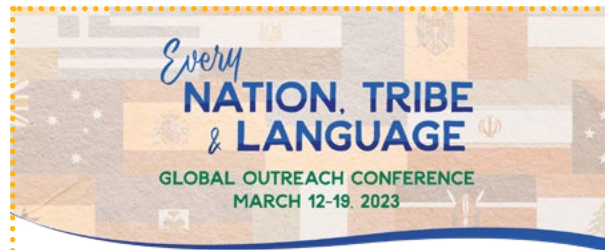

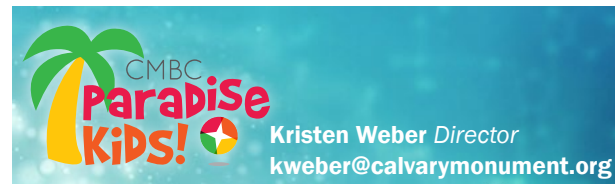
### Women's Spring Bible Study

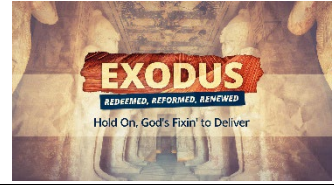

Why did God harden Pharaoh's heart? (Ex. 4:16; Rom. 9:17)</li> <li>2. What are some characteristics or qualities embedded in the life of a person who has a hard heart towards the things of God?</li> <li>3. God is patient with Pharaoh, giving him many opportunities to change course and free the Hebrew people, but Pharaoh refuses again and again. Discuss the attributes of God that are revealed in the plague narrative of Exodus.</li> <li>4. How does the plague of darkness echo back to the beginning of the creation narrative? In what ways might we observe the first 9 plagues as de-creation events in the land of Pharaoh?</li> <li>5. 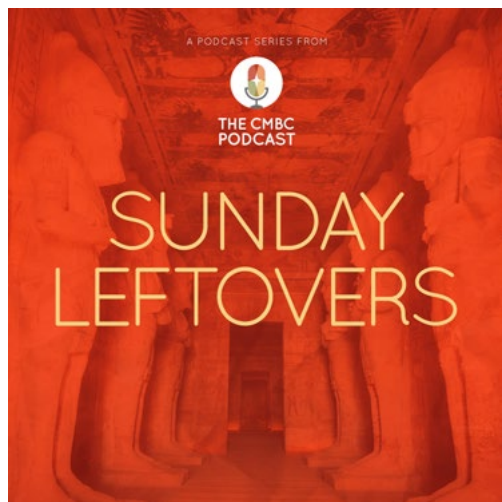

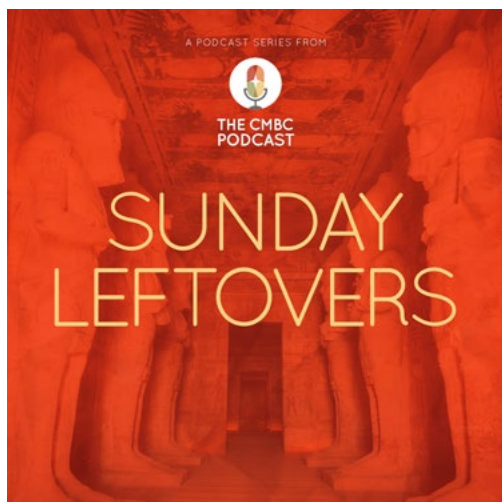
