How does the firstfruit offering orient our minds towards a Risen Messiah? 3. Read Genesis 3:1-7 & Matthew 4:1-11. Make comparisons and contrasts to these two temptations experiences. 4. Look at 1 Corinthians 15:23-26 together. When considering Jesus' future 2nd coming, what excites and motivates you, what gives you hope for today? 5. How do verses 24-28 form our understandings of how the Father and Son relate to one another?
