<p><b>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</b></p> <p>Start with <b>Prayer</b> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b>Read the Text</b> -read the text together. (John 4:4-42)</p> <p><b>Discussion Guiding Questions:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Reflect on the various opportunities and contexts that God makes available to you each day, so that you might worship Him.</li> <li>2. What are the circumstances that could have kept Jesus from seeing this encounter as an opportunity to worship the Father?</li> <li>3. Considering John 4:13-18, how does Jesus begin to reveal and offer hope to the Samaritan woman?</li> <li>4. Giving thought to this encounter, especially Jesus' words in verses 19-26, take time to discuss the following questions. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. What is worship?</li> <li>b. Who are we to worship?</li> <li>c. Why are we to worship?</li> <li>d. Where are we to worship?</li> <li>e. When are we to worship?</li> <li>f. How are we to worship?</li> </ol> </li> <li>5.
