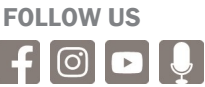

Too often people have such a strong desire to have the chronology of the future plans of God figured out that they overlook a clear teaching of Scripture. The truth of the blessed hope is to have a transformative impact upon the way believers live. One of the last writers of the New Testament, the Apostle John, makes this clear as he writes to believers he dearly loves. Today we see that believers who look forward to the return of Christ, are to have their lives transformed by that blessed hope.
