<p>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with Prayer -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p>Read the Text -read the text together. (Luke 5:1-11)</p> <p>Discussion Guiding Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Discuss some of the most significant ways that Jesus demonstrated a desire to live and be in community with the very people that he came to seek and save. What are some scriptures that detail Jesus' heart for people? 2. Why do you think it was so important for Jesus to invite people to join with him in the work that God had given him to do? What does Jesus' calling of disciples reveal to us about God's desire to use and work in and through us? 3. How does Jesus use the profession of fishing, and the miraculous catch of fish to stir the imaginations of his first followers towards something that would be far greater? 4. In way ways does the posture of Peter in verse 8 demonstrate that he was ready to be mightily used of God? How does this correspond with Paul's words to the Corinthian church about God's power being made perfect in our weakness? 5. Take time personally or in your group to reflect on the fullness of Jesus' words, "Follow me." What would be the characteristics of a Christian community that had fully embraced and committed to living and functioning in this world as Jesus did? <p>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
