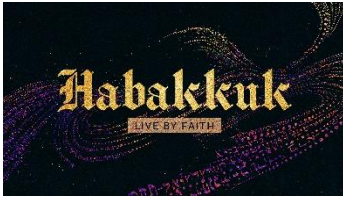
Sympathy

Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (Habakkuk 2:2-5)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What was the nature of the vision as it is described in Habakkuk 2:2-3? 2. Why is it often difficult for us to wait patiently on the Lord when turmoil and distress describe our current circumstances? 3. In verses 4-5 there are contrasts between the character of the pride-filled Babylonians, and the righteous. Identify and name the differences between these two groups. 4. In practical measures, what attributes or qualities are seen in the life of a person who lives by faith? 5. Reflect on the other passages in the New Testament where authors used Habakkuk 2:4 (Rom. 1:16-17; Gal. 3:11; Heb. 10:32-38). Read them together, then discuss how and why this instruction remained so relevant to the early church. Also discuss how and why this instruction remains so vital for our churches today. <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge us to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are we motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating us to apply some of the principles from this passage to our families, careers, communities, or churches? 4. How might Jesus be using us to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
