Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>Read the Text</u></b> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 4:6-13)</p> <p><b><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does the critiquing, criticizing, and judging of other Christian workers put us in danger of being prideful and puffed up? (vs. 6)</li> <li>2. What are the dangers of looking at other ministries or churches and comparing ourselves to them?</li> <li>3. Talk about the ways that pride is harmful to the body of Christ. How does pride work against unity and promote division within the body of Christ?</li> <li>4. What postures or attitudes might be required of believers in order to keep from being shipwrecked by pride? Talk about specific words, phrases, actions or postures that demonstrate humility.</li> <li>5. Explore verses 10-13 together, take note of postures and behaviors that Paul associates with the stewardship of the Body of Christ.</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth &amp; Discipleship:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others?</li> <li>3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church?</li> <li>4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
