<p style="text-align: center;">Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with <u>Prayer</u> -ask Jesus to guide your time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 1:10-17)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What clues in verses 10-11 reveal that Paul is directing his appeal towards the family of God, who are called together under the Lordship of Jesus Christ? 2. How does the Church demonstrate “same mindedness?” (Consider Philippians 2:5-8, and Romans 12). 3. Talk about the danger of aligning ourselves too closely with one specific teacher, pastor, or leader. Within the Church, how might too close of an alignment with one person orient us towards others (within Christ) who may disagree with that person? 4. Why was it so important for Paul to understand and remain laser focused on the purpose for which God had sent him as an apostle to the people of God in Corinth? 5. In what ways did Paul demonstrate leading from weaknesses? Why was this an important component of his ministry? How might we follow his example today? (1 Cor. 1:17; 2:1-5) <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church? 4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
