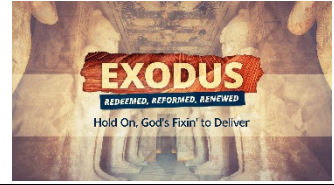

<p><b>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</b></p> <p>Start with <b>Prayer</b> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>Read the Text</u></b> -Exodus 9:13-10:29 (or portions of it).</p> <p><b><u>Questions for Reflection &amp; Discussion:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Why did God harden Pharaoh's heart? (Ex. 4:16; Rom. 9:17)</li> <li>2. What are some characteristics or qualities embedded in the life of a person who has a hard heart towards the things of God?</li> <li>3. God is patient with Pharaoh, giving him many opportunities to change course and free the Hebrew people, but Pharaoh refuses again and again. Discuss the attributes of God that are revealed in the plague narrative of Exodus.</li> <li>4. How does the plague of darkness echo back to the beginning of the creation narrative? In what ways might we observe the first 9 plagues as de-creation events in the land of Pharaoh?</li> <li>5. What are some of your broader takeaways concerning the first 9 plagues that God has brought upon Egypt?</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation &amp; Application:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text challenge us to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. How are we motivated to grow in a greater love for others?</li> <li>3. How might Jesus be motivating us to apply some of the principles from this passage to our families, careers, communities, or churches?</li> <li>4. How might Jesus be using us to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
