<p>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with Prayer -ask Jesus to guide your time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p>Read the Text -read the text together. (1 Cor. 15:12-19)</p> <p>Discussion Guiding Questions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. In this troubling text we are confronted with the consequence of a Christ who didn't raise from the dead. Explore together the 7 implications Paul reveals in the text. Which is most striking or troubling to you? 2. In what ways would your life look different, had Jesus not physically risen from the dead? 3. How has the resurrection of Jesus given you hope for the future, empowering you to live day-by-day? 4. In a very real sense, we have already experienced resurrection dynamics, when we were brought from spiritually dead, to spiritually alive in Christ. Talk about the ways your life changed after you experienced your spiritual resurrection. 5. In verse 19, Paul says, "if in Christ we have hope in this life only, we are of all people most to be pitied." Thankfully, we have passages like 1 Peter 1:3-9, to remind us we have so much more to hope for than this life! Read and explore 1 Peter 1:3-9 together, make observations regarding our future hope. <p>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church? 4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
