

"Does Information Make Us Wiser?"
Calvary Monument Bible Church
July 14, 2024 Pastor Robert Reid

There has not been a time when we have had more opportunity to have access to information. David Schilling noted that "until 1900 human knowledge doubled approximately every century... But [now] on average human knowledge is doubling every 13 months. According to IBM, the build out of the 'internet of things' will lead to the doubling of knowledge every 12 hours." Has this resulted in more wisdom? Perhaps we need wisdom that is from above — not just more information.
