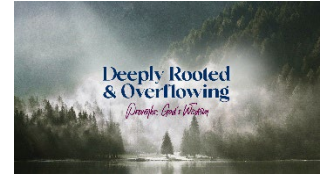

<p><b>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</b></p> <p>Start with <b>Prayer</b> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>Read the Text</u></b> – Proverbs 8</p> <p><b><u>Questions for Reflection &amp; Discussion:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Reflecting on verses 8:1-11, who is wisdom calling out to? What is it that she is saying?</li> <li>2. Chapter 8:12-21 lead us to consider the fruit of hearing and obeying the voice of wisdom. After reading these verses, take time to discuss the fruit of following wisdom's voice.</li> <li>3. In verses 22-31, we are given figurative and poetic words and images that direct our minds back to the beginning, to the creation of the world. What words or phrases seem directly connected to Jesus? Reflect on the following passages and connect them to Jesus' work in the creation of all things. (1 Cor. 8:6; Heb. 1:2-3; Jn. 1:1-5; Col. 1:16)</li> <li>4. Verse 32 brings us back to our posture in the reception of wisdom. We are to remain as children in our hearing, receiving, and application of God's wisdom. Over the past 3 weeks, we have discussed many qualities related to child-like faith. What are some qualities that have stood out? How can we remain as children, even as we age?</li> <li>5. Verses 32-36 contrast the blessing for those who listen and apply God's wisdom, and the outcome for those who despise or neglect God's wisdom. Reading these verses together, what are the blessings for those who apply wisdom to life? (vss. 32-35) What do we proclaim when we despise or neglect God's wisdom? (vs. 36)</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation &amp; Application:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another?</li> <li>3. What principles could be applied to our family life, careers, communities, or congregational life?</li> <li>4. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
