Spend some time in your group discussing and reflecting on the value of ministry partnerships in your lives. Who has God placed in your life as a partner in the advancement of the gospel? Why are you thankful for their presence, and how have they supported, encouraged and been a source of joy for you in life and ministry? 2. What was it that set Timothy apart from other ministry leaders that Paul knew? Why did Paul give this quality such priority? (vs. 20-21). 3. How did Paul describe both Timothy and Epaphroditus' relationship to himself? (vss. 22, 25). 4. In what ways can we see the example of Christ, as Paul wrote in 2:5-11, through the lives and ministry examples of Timothy and Epaphroditus? 5. When we engage in meaningful Christian partnerships, how can God use these relationships to grow humility and interdependence within and among our Christian community? <p><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation & Application:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge us to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are we motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3.
