

Next Steps: Home-Group Study and/or Personal Discipleship Guide

Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!

Start with **Prayer** -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.

Read the Text - Proverbs 1:1-9

Ouestions for Reflection & Discussion:

- 1. Read 1 Kings 3:5-15, then journal or discuss Solomon's request and God's gift of wisdom. Why would it please God that Solomon asked for wisdom above long life or riches? How would wisdom become an important part of Solomon's reign as King? What tasks would he perform that would require great wisdom and insight? (1 Kings. 3:16-28; 1 Kings 6)
- 2. Though Solomon was one of the wisest kings to ever reign, he still had his blind spots. Read, review, and reflect on the contents of 1 Kings 11. Where did King Solomon betray the gift of wisdom that was given to him by God? What were his blind spots, and how did his sins affect the people that he was leading?
- 3. What effect does Solomon hope that his proverbs will have among the people that receive, hear, and apply them? (Proverbs 1:1-6)
- 4. Take time to discuss or journal your reflections on the term, "the fear of the Lord". What does it mean to fear the Lord? How might the fear of the Lord look in the life of a person who is seeking to faithfully live as a follower of Jesus? (Ps. 34; Prov. 2:3-5; 8:13; 9:10; Ps. 19:9, 25:14; 31:19; 130:4; Ecc. 12:13-14)
- 5. How are we to receive the Proverbs? (Prov. 1:8-9) How does this posture line up with later teaching from Jesus? (Matt. 18:2-5)

Questions guiding Spiritual Formation & Application:

- 1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God?
- 2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another?
- 3. What principles could be applied to our family life, careers, communities, or congregational life?
- 4. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?
- 5. Who is currently in our lives that needs an invitation to meet Jesus or be part of a kind and gracious Christian community?
