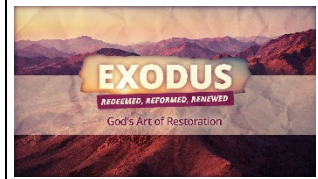

<p><b>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</b></p> <p>Start with <b>Prayer</b> -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>Read the Text</u></b> -Exodus 33-34 (whole or part)</p> <p><b><u>Questions for Reflection &amp; Discussion:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Following Israel's sin of idolatry, what portions of 33:7-11 would serve as a source of hope for Moses and the people?</li> <li>2. Examine Moses' three primary requests of the Lord in 33:13, 15-16, and 18. How does the Lord respond to each request?</li> <li>3. Read chapter 34:5-9 together and make note of how God describes his own nature and character. What are your takeaways from God's self-disclosure?</li> <li>4. In verses 11-28 of chapter 34, God explains some appropriate responses from the people. How were they to respond to the covenant faithfulness of God? How might we respond today, as the Church, to God's great faithfulness?</li> <li>5. Chapter 34:29-35 describe how Moses was change, after his encounter with God. Read this together, and then parallel it with 2 Corinthians 3:12-18. Discuss the similarities. As an unveiled people, who live in the freedom of the Spirit, how might we reflect the glory of the God in the world we inhabit?</li> </ol> <p><b><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation &amp; Application:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text challenge us to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. How are we motivated to grow in a greater love for others?</li> <li>3. How might Jesus be motivating us to apply some of the principles from this passage to our families, careers, communities, or churches?</li> <li>4. How might Jesus be using us to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
