Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 11:2-16)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Take time to place this portion of Paul's writing within the broader context of his letter to the people of God in Corinth. What has he written before, and what will he write immediately after, that help to inform what he is saying here? (8-11:34) 2. Within this text (11:2-16) where can we see a reflection of Paul's previous teaching related to believer's laying down their rights and freedoms for the glory of God and good of one another? 3. As we have been created to rely on God, we have also been created with a need for one another. Talk about how God has designed each gender to uniquely suit or complement the other. 4. While both men and women are to exercise their gifts in corporate worship gatherings of the church, what distinctions does he draw between the genders? 5. How can embracing God's design in both our interdependence and distinctions be a testimony or salt and light to a not yet believing world? <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
