Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b><u>READ THE TEXT</u></b> – Mark 2:1-3:6</p> <p><b><u>QUESTIONS FOR REFLECTION &amp; DISCUSSION:</u></b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. What were some of the things about Jesus’ life and ministry that were so disruptive and disturbing to the religious leaders of his day?</li> <li>2. After reading through the text, take inventory of and discuss the varying ways in which Jesus responded to the religious leader’s objections.</li> <li>3. How does Jesus use the opportunity of criticism to clarify his purpose for coming and the mission that he had been given by the Father? (vss. 2:8-10; 17; 19-20; 27-28; 3:4).</li> <li>4. In 2:18-22, Jesus uses three parables to clarify the significance of both his presence and his teaching. What do the illustrations describe to us about first, how the people should have responded to his physical presence, then second, how they should have responded to his teachings?</li> <li>5. Spend some time in thoughtful reflection and discussion on the Sabbath, considering how it is practiced and applied in the life of the Christian today. How is Jesus our true and ultimate Sabbath? Then, how might the disciple of Jesus, practice and apply the Sabbath every day of their life? How might Jesus be using us to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
