<p style="text-align: center;">Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with <u>Prayer</u> -ask Jesus to guide your time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> -read the text together. (Luke 19:28-44)</p> <p><u>Discussion Guiding Questions:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. What is the significance of Luke highlighting the reality that Jesus was, “drawing near” to the city of Jerusalem? How does the Triumphal Entry highlight the incarnational (God with us) components of Jesus’ ministry? 2. In verses 37-40, Jesus’ disciples are quick to worship him, and the Pharisees are quick to dismiss their worship. How do groups miss out on who Jesus truly was, and what he was truly offering? 3. Read verses 41-44 again, then turn to Matthew 23 and read verses 37-39. What provokes or moves Jesus to tears? 4. What would come upon the people as a result of peace being hidden from their eyes? 5. Jesus offers peace, Paul proclaims the gospel of peace (Eph. 6:15). Who is the one who provides eternal peace? How do we know that we have received this peace? And how should the existence of this peace provided in Jesus, inform the patterns, attitudes, and habits of our lives? 6. Who has God placed in our lives that needs to hear about this peace, and see the implications of this peace lived out? <p><u>Questions towards Spiritual Growth & Discipleship:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God? 2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others? 3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church? 4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
