**The 1st Corinthians Question:** How do we live as disciples of Jesus and function together as his Church in an overwhelmingly unbelieving world?

*Taking hold of all we have been given in Christ, we handle trivial matters internally; using the kingdom wisdom of humility and sacrificial love, we express the righteousness of Christ within our faith community, stirring one another up towards love and good works.*

<p><b>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</b></p> <p>Start with <b>Prayer</b> -ask Jesus to guide your time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><b>Read the Text</b> -read the text together. (1 Cor. 6:1-11)</p> <p><b>Discussion Guiding Questions:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. When trivial matters erupt within the body of Christ, where does Paul instruct that they should be handled? (vss.1-4) Why does Paul suggest that it is important for the church to handle trivial matters internally?</li> <li>2. What does Paul mean in verse 7? Why is it a defeat for believers in the church to have lawsuits against one another? How does Paul suggest that the church avoid these frivolous lawsuits? (vss. 7-8)</li> <li>3. How does Paul suggest that the church is acting when they engage, endorse and practice filing frivolous lawsuits against one another in public courts? (vss. 8-9)</li> <li>4. Paul condemns a number of different sins in verses 9-10, make a few observations from this list, what is the root and nature of these sins? How do you see pride? How do you see consumption and indulgence in this list?</li> <li>5. Rather than living as unrighteous, Paul call us to live in the reality in which we have been created in Christ Jesus. What does this look like? (vs. 11) What is your, "and such were some of you" story? How has God transformed your life?</li> </ol> <p><b>Questions towards Spiritual Growth &amp; Discipleship:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. How does this text challenge you to grow in a greater love for God?</li> <li>2. How are you motivated to grow in a greater love for others?</li> <li>3. How might Jesus be motivating you apply some of the principles from this passage to your family, career, community, or church?</li> <li>4. How might Jesus be using you to draw those that do not know him, unto himself?</li> <li>5.
