2.	Since Christ lived in this manner, and was obedient unto death, what was God's response (vss. 9-11) and how does God's response to Jesus' faithfulness give us great hope and provide us with an opportunity to experience abundant life?	
3.	What might it look like for a believer today to work out his or her salvation with, "fear and trembling?" Share examples from your personal life. (vs. 12-13)	
4.	In verse 13 Paul encourages the Christian community in Philippi that God is working through them for his good pleasure. Since this is the case, what qualities does Paul expect will be present within their	<u>Prayer</u> <u>Requests</u>
5.	community? (vss. 14-18) How well are our churches representing these qualities? Where could we do better? What have we done well? Why is it hard and uncomfortable to live in this manner in our world today?	Family
