- 3. Receive daily prayer content through our CMBC app. You can find the CMBC app, and download it for free, in the App Store (iPhone users), or Google Play store (Android users). Make sure you opt in for notifications! This content will be available on the app even if you prefer not to get notifications just open your app on March 7!

Finally, we desire for this 40 Days of Prayer to supplement, not overtake, your current daily prayer habits and practices. Please continue to make use of your monthly prayer calendar (to pray for our congregation, ministries, and global partners) and weekly Intercessor (to pray for more pressing and time sensitive needs within our body) alongside of, and together with, your 40 day prayer journal.
