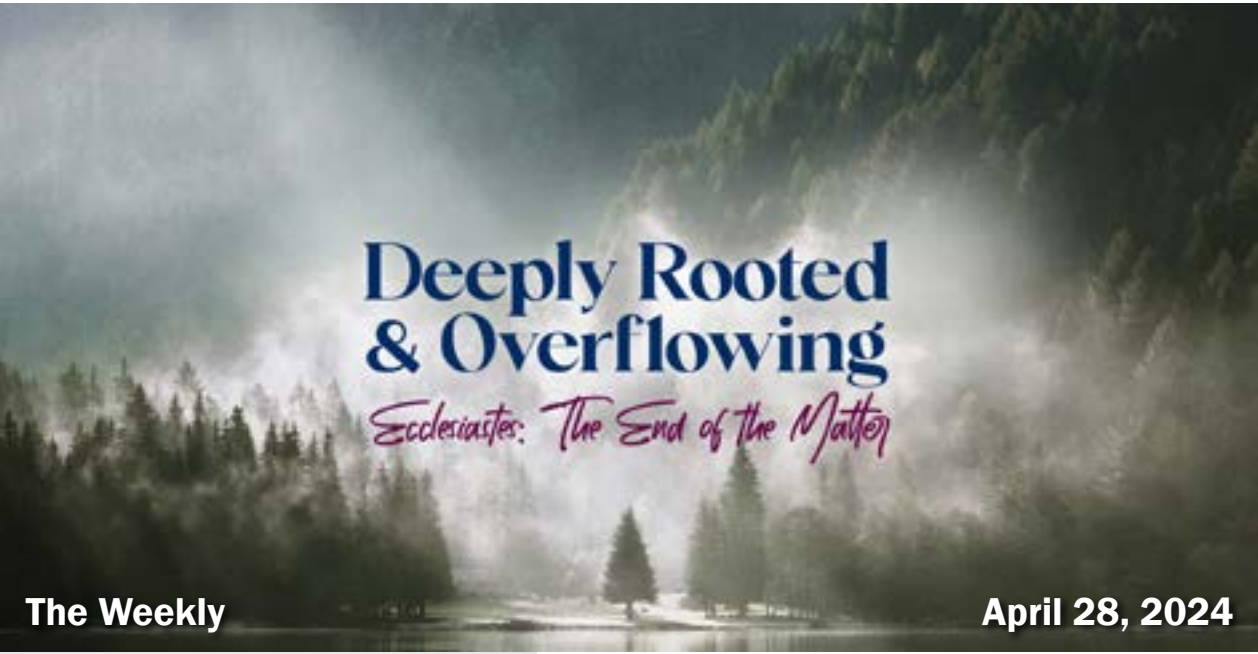

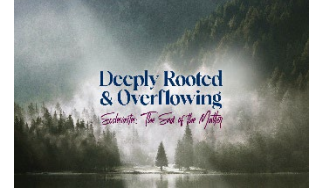

| <p>Get together as a family or with a friend or group of friends this week!</p> <p>Start with Prayer -ask Jesus to guide our time together. Go over prayer requests together.</p> <p><u>Read the Text</u> – Ecclesiastes 11:9-12:14</p> <p><u>Questions for Reflection & Discussion:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does Ecclesiastes 11:9 form a nice chain link into the opening of chapter 12? What does the rejoicing in 11:9-10 turn into at the beginning of chapter 12? Journal or share about how you have experienced this transition in your own life? How does rejoicing remain present, while we also give way to greater remembering and reflection on the past? 2. Discuss or take time to journal about the characteristics of aging as described by Solomon in 12:1-7. What are your takeaways or observations from these verses? 3. What or where are the cultural landmarks or spaces located that are communicating or proclaiming that this current life is all there is? How does this statement lead or point us away from Jesus and toward aimlessness and hopelessness? In what ways does the gospel counteract this message, giving us so much more than just this life to live for? 4. How does Solomon describe his words in verses 9-12? What can the follower of Jesus learn from Solomon about how we should employ or utilize our own words? 5. Take time to break apart and discuss verses 13-14. How do we practice and apply living in the “fear of the Lord?” What are the commands of Jesus? How is the command of Jesus counter to the ways of the world? In what ways might God work through individuals or communities that are committed to living under, practicing, and applying verses 13-14? <p><u>Questions guiding Spiritual Formation & Application:</u></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How does this text invite us to grow in a greater love for God? 2. What lessons within this text move us towards growing in our love for one another? 3. What principles could be applied to our family life, careers, communities, or congregational life? 4. Consider how Jesus could use our application of the principles in this text to draw those that do not know him, unto himself? 5.
