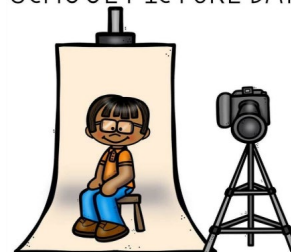

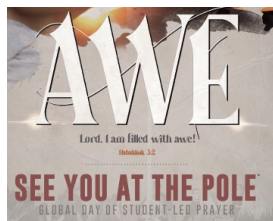


## **DOUG MICKAN AND FRIENDS – FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 12**

## **GYM ROOF REPAIR**

In March, heavy winds caused the EPDM rubber roof membrane to become separated from the roof decking and insulation, compromising the roof system. Weathercraft Inc. evaluated the roof and temporarily weighted it down with blocks. They determined that the membrane was still intact but needed to be replaced before it tears and damages the insulation underneath. They bid the project at \$67,000. The work has now been completed.
