Faith Formation Opportunities this Fall

- Sunday Morning Bible Study, 9:30-10:15 am: We are making a change this fall: beginning Sept. 7, we will have one adult class that will meet in the fellowship hall, rather than our 3 smaller classes. We will be guided by Lisa Harper's A Jesus Shaped Life: How Biblically Sound Theology Deepens Our Relationship with God and Each Other. When we hear the word "theology," we may think of boring, difficult study of ancient Scholars. But theology is just a conversation about God, one that invites us to experience God in all his fullness rather than just memorizing facts about God. Have you wondered about things like the Trinity - how can God be both One and Three? Or how Jesus is both human and divine? This seven week study is your invitation to explore questions like these and examine the depths of God's character, God's love for you, and how your relationship with God transforms you. Whether you've never been part of a Bible study group, you've attended Sunday School from the time you were a child, or somewhere in between, this class is for you! Some of our current Sunday morning Bible study teachers will be leading the class. Come join us as we seek to shape our lives to look more like Jesus! We also have classes for our children and youth, so there is something for your whole family.
- Midweek Spiritual Formation, Wednesdays at noon: Beginning Sept. 3, Rev. Steven Harris will be leading a midweek spiritual formations class on Church History. This class will provide an understanding of how the church and Christian beliefs evolved from the first century on. Join us in person or by Zoom: https://bit.ly/radiancebiblestudy.
