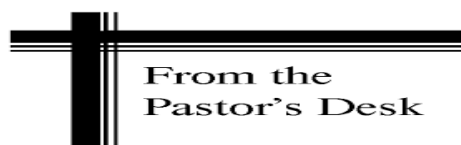

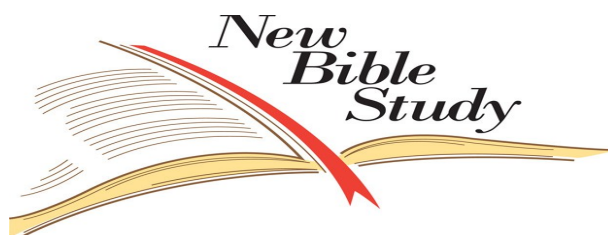
youth Ministry NEWS
