1. God Knows Me Personally	Isaiah 43:1	God Calls Us by Name	God knows each of us individually, affirming our identity and belonging.	Live boldly, knowing you are seen and valued. Cultivate intimacy through prayer and worship.
		Personal Relationship	God desires genuine connection, understanding our fears, joys, and dreams.	Share your heart with Him and rely on His guidance. Authentic relationships fosters peace and direction.
		Intimacy Brings Security	Knowing we belong to God assures protection and care.	Trust in God's presence to face life's challenges with courage. Feel secure and loved in His care.
2. God Knows My Needs	Matthew 6:8	He Understands Before We Ask	God knows our needs and desires before we articulate them.	Focus on faithful action, gratitude, and patience. Trust in God's provision and timing.
		Providence and Care	God orchestrates circumstances to meet our needs, sometimes unexpectedly.	Recognize His providence and respond in faith, reducing worry and promoting contentment.
		Prayer Is Connection	Prayer aligns us with God, strengthening our relationship.	View prayer as relational, not transactional. Use it to seek guidance, peace, and reassurance.
3. God Knows My Struggles	Psalm 34:17	God Hears Our Cries	God listens attentively to our pain; no struggle is invisible to Him.	Bring your struggles to Him in prayer, trusting in His deliverance.
		Deliverance Is Assured	God acts on our behalf in His timing.	Maintain patience and faith, knowing God's help is guaranteed.

		Trials Build Character	Struggles refine faith and develop perseverance.	Allow trials to strengthen resilience and empathy, shaping your spiritual growth.
4. God Knows My Heart	1 Samuel 16:7	God Sees Beyond Appearances	God evaluates our inner motives, not outward appearances.	Live authentically and cultivate integrity in thought and action.
		He Understands Our Thoughts	God knows unspoken thoughts and intentions.	Redirect thoughts toward godly reflection, enhancing spiritual maturity.
		Encouragement to Purity	Awareness of God's observation inspires moral integrity.	Prioritize character over appearance, strengthening your witness and relationships.
5. God Knows My Purpose	Jeremiah 1:5	God Has a Plan for Each of Us	Every life has a divine purpose, tailored by God.	Embrace your unique gifts and calling; pursue service with confidence.
		Unique Calling	Each believer has specific roles in God's kingdom.	Focus on your strengths and contributions rather than imitation.
		Confidence in Living Out Purpose	God's knowledge brings clarity and courage in fulfilling our mission.	Take faithful steps in life and ministry, guided by God's plan.
6. God Knows Me Eternally	John 10:14-15	Security in His Love	God's eternal knowledge assures constant care and protection.	Live with hope and peace, trusting God's unchanging love.
		Unchanging Relationship	God's connection is steadfast and reliable.	Let this awareness foster trust and resilience in daily life.
		Hope Beyond Life	Eternal knowledge guarantees our place in God's kingdom.	Let hope shape priorities, relationships, and faithful service today.
