Titus 3:4–7 (KJV)

4 But after that the kindness and love of God our Saviour toward man appeared,

5 Not by works of righteousness which we have done,

but according to His mercy He saved us,

by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

6 Which He shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

7 That being justified by His grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

Ephesians 2:4–8 (KJV)

- 4 But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith He loved us,
- 5 Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)
- 6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:
- 7 That in the ages to come He might shew the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.
- 8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God.

Grace First Mentioned (a great Bible Study Practice)

Genesis 6:8 (KJV)

"But Noah found grace in the eyes of the LORD."

- Grace shines brightest when judgment looms darkest.
- Grace is not earned it is freely given.
- Grace preserves a remnant.
- Grace builds, it doesn't just sit idle.

The first time GRACE is mentioned in the Bible, it doesn't erase the flood — it builds the boat.

The Thread of Grace

- Adam & Eve Grace covered their shame.
- Cain Grace marked him for protection.
- Seth's Line Grace opened the door to call on God.
- Enoch Grace made intimacy with God possible.
- Lamech Grace promised relief in the curse.
- Noah Grace saved when judgment fell.

The Hope for Us Today

- The same God who clothed Adam, spared Cain, walked with Enoch, and gave Noah favor says to us:
 - "My grace is sufficient for you."
- You don't have to invent grace.
- You don't have to earn grace.
- You just have to see it, receive it, and respond to it.

Practical Application of Grace

- Grace keeps your heart soft protects you from becoming a hater.
- Grace breaks the cycle of offense stops hurt from multiplying.
- Grace frees you to celebrate others cheer instead of compare.
- Grace makes you better, not bitter.

The quickest path to becoming a hater is withholding grace. The surest path to freedom is giving it.

The Reward of Giving Grace

- Favor with People Grace opens doors of trust. (Proverbs 3:3–4)
- Influence & Promotion Grace-carriers are invited to bigger tables.
- Christlikeness in Action Grace makes us look like JESUS.

The Bible's Arc of Grace

- First mention: "But Noah found grace..." (Gen. 6:8).
- Last mention: "The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you all. Amen." (Rev. 22:21).

The Bible opens and closes the floodgates with GRACE.
