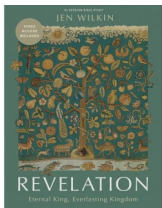

FOUR REASONS FOR FASTING (Part 1)

1. To _____ ourselves to Jesus.

*"And so, dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all He has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice - the kind He will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship Him."
Romans 12:1 NLT*

*"Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? So you must honor God with your body."
1 Corinthians 6:19-20 NLT*
