Man is living in a crisis time.

The tribulation is not simply the apex of natural consequences. The tribulation is the active _____ of God brought to pass in the world.

First, let's look at the time period the tribulation occupies.

There will be 70 periods of 7 years: 490 years total.

But you must remember those years at this time in history were _____ days.

During the seven-year tribulation, Israel is going to have its _____.

Antichrist is going to be against God, obviously, and he's going to wear out the saints of the Most High.

The terrible terror of the tribulation begins when all of the demons and Satan himself are thrown out of heaven and their total domain is the earth and the desecration of the temple takes place.

Antichrist is going to set up an _____ to himself in the temple, and that is the desecration of the temple.

Israel's persecution is going to be kind of interesting.

Only a certain amount of the Jews are going to escape, one out of three. The remaining two-thirds, the antichrist is going to begin to slaughter.

So that's the period, a seven-year tribulation divided into two equal parts.

Now then, what about the _____?

Zephaniah describes the "Day of the Lord" in a rapid-fire way, and this is another name for the Tribulation.

Man has had his day. Now God is going to have His day.

You can study all of them, and you will never find one single word that in any way _____ the punishment.

Jesus describes the Tribulation in Matthew 24.

I think that verses 4 through 8 of Matthew 24 speak of the first half of the tribulation. It's a possibility. And if that's true, then the first few seals also apply to the first half of the tribulation, and I may have problems with that. But whether you can match these with the seals, I'm not sure.
