- B. The book of Jonah is one of the smallest books of the old testament.
- C.It is the only book of the prophets that focuses on the prophet, Jonah, and not on what he said.
- D.Every chapter, every verse in Jonah is about the grandeur of our God.

EVERYONE WITH A PROUD HEART IS DETESTABLE TO THE LORD; BE ASSURED, HE WILL NOT GO UNPUNISHED. **Proverbs**16:5

D. Sometimes the sin itself punishes us.

THE VIOLENCE OF THE WICKED SWEEPS THEM AWAY BECAUSE THEY REFUSE TO ACT JUSTLY. Proverbs 21:7

E. Sin sets up strains in the structure of life which can only end in breakdown.
