SEA OF GALILEE

Day 1

Flights from Fort Wayne or alternative nearby airports, such as Detroit Airport, to Tel Aviv.

Day 2

Upon arrival, our representative will meet you inside the baggage claim area and escort you to your guide and driver for a trip north to Galilee, with stops at Caesarea Maritima to discuss the Acts of the Apostles and Mount Carmel, Elijah's site, before checking in at the Leonardo Hotel—just a five-minute walk from the Promenade—dinner and overnight.

Day 3

After breakfast, visit Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16), Nazareth's Mount Precipice, Mary's Well, and Mount Tabor's Transfiguration site; walk part of the ancient trail from Nazareth to Capernaum, tour Galilee's Jesus and Gentile sites, see the Jordan River, enjoy dinner and overnight, then stroll the promenade to experience local life, ancient Tiberias ruins, and enjoy the Gelato.

Day 4

After breakfast, visit Mount Beatitudes, Peter's Primacy, and Eramos Cave, then Tabgha, walk from Peter's Primacy to Capernaum, enjoy a boat ride, visit and worship in Magdala, return to the hotel for dinner, followed by a reflection meeting on your Galilee experience, overnight.

Day 5

After breakfast, check out and drive to Jerusalem via the Jordan Valley for a city view, then proceed to Bethlehem to visit the Nativity Church, its surrounding caves, Shepherd's Field, and Herod's burial fortress, check in at St. Elias Hotel for dinner. After dinner, enjoy a complimentary bus tour of Bethlehem to experience local life, ending with the famous local dessert, Knafeh.

Day 6

After breakfast, visit the plaza around the Dome of the Rock and view the Golden Gate area from inside; then explore St. Anne's Church, Bethesda Pools, the Wailing Wall, Teaching Steps, Upper Room, Peter Gallicantu, and Jesus' Jail. See the model of Jerusalem in Jesus' time, visit Elah Valley—the site of David and Goliath's battle—and the surrounding biblical valleys before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight

Day 7

After breakfast, visit Jericho to see the oldest sycamore tree at the Greek Monastery of Elisha, view Mount Temptation, and the ancient road to Jerusalem; visit the Baptismal site, explore Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered, and consider whether John the Baptist was an Essene, then see the Dead Sea before returning to the hotel for dinner and overnight.



JERUSALEM

Day 8

After breakfast, explore the Old City of Jerusalem, walk the Way of the Cross, visit the Holy Sepulchre and the hidden caves beneath it, see the 2,850-year-old Broad Wall built by Hezekiah, walk the Cardo, visit the Citadel Museum, and view the Essenes Gate; then return to Bethlehem for dinner with a Christian family, overnight.

Day 9

After breakfast, visit the Mount of Olives and the Palm Sunday path, stop at Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, then visit Gethsemane and the Church of All Nations; pass by the Beit Phage area and, if accessible, visit Bethany and the home of Lazarus. End the day at the Central Armenian Quarter to attend the liturgy at St. James Church, dinner and overnight.

Day 10

After breakfast, enjoy some free time before your transfer to the airport for your journey back home—away from home.

JORDAN EXTENSION

After breakfast and check-out, drive to the border for crossing into Jordan, where you will be met and assisted upon arrival. Continue to Petra, stopping en route to explore the ancient Roman city of Jerash. Upon arrival in Petra, check in at the Movenpick Hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 11

After breakfast, enjoy a full visit to Petra; return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 12

After breakfast, check out and drive to Amman, visiting Madaba to see the ancient mosaic map, then continue to Mount Nebo, the traditional site of Moses' view of the Promised Land and reflection on the Exodus; conclude with a panoramic view of ancient Philadelphia (Amman), then check in at the Movenpick Amman for dinner and overnight.

Day 13

After breakfast, transfer to Amman Airport for your flight home.

Alternatively, cross back into Israel, meet and assist at the border, enjoy some free time in Jerusalem, and then transfer to the airport.

The exact schedule for this day will be finalized based on flight times.
