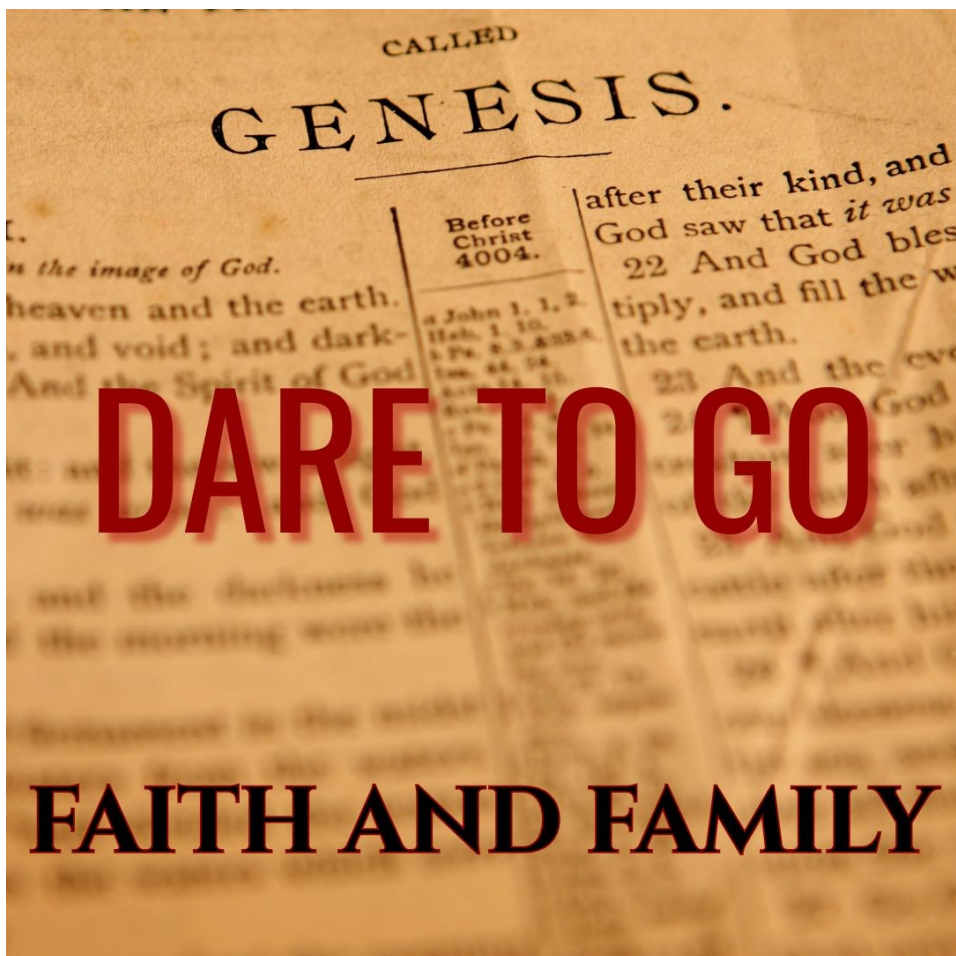

1. ABRAM _____ GOD’S CALL.

Now the Lord said to Abram, “Go from your country and your kindred and your father’s house to the land that I will show you. ²And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. ³I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.” (Genesis 12:1-3)

A. GOD CAN _____ US IN VARIOUS WAYS.

So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ. (Romans 10:17)

B. WE NEED TO _____ GOD’S CALL.

By faith Abraham obeyed when he was called to go out to a place that he was to receive as an inheritance. And he went out, not knowing where he was going. (Hebrews 11:8)

2. THE CALL TOOK ABRAM OUT OF HIS _____ ZONE.

So Abram went, as the Lord had told him, and Lot went with him. Abram was seventy-five years old when he departed from Haran. ⁵And Abram took Sarai his wife, and Lot his brother’s son, and all their possessions that they had gathered, and the people that they had acquired in Haran, and they set out to go to the land of Canaan. When they came to the land of Canaan, ⁶Abram passed through the land to the place at Shechem, to the oak of Moreh. At that time the Canaanites were in the land. (Genesis 12:4-6)

A. FAITH WILL _____ US TO NEW EXPERIENCES.

Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” (John 8:12)

When he has brought out all his own, he goes before them, and the sheep follow him, for they know his voice. (John 10:4)

3. ABRAM GAVE UP _____ TO GOD'S LEADING.

Then the Lord appeared to Abram and said, "To your offspring I will give this land." So he built there an altar to the Lord, who had appeared to him. ⁸From there he moved to the hill country on the east of Bethel and pitched his tent, with Bethel on the west and Ai on the east. And there he built an altar to the Lord and called upon the name of the Lord. ⁹And Abram journeyed on, still going toward the Negeb. (Genesis 12:7-9)

A. _____ IS THE HARDEST PART OF _____ CHRIST.

Trust in the LORD, and do good dwell in the land and befriend faithfulness. Delight yourself in the LORD, and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the LORD; trust in him, and he will act. He will bring forth your righteousness as the light and your justice as the noonday. Be still before the LORD and wait patiently for him; (Psalm 37:3-7a)
