



Why a Weekly Observance of the Lord's Supper?

One of the most distinctive practices of the Pleasant Grove Road church is our weekly observance of the Lord's Supper. Some may ask, "Why every Sunday? Isn't that too often?" The answer is simple, we follow the example and teaching of the New Testament.

This was instituted by Christ. On the night He was betrayed, Jesus took bread and fruit of the vine and said, "Do this in remembrance of me" (Luke 22:19–20). The Lord's Supper is not a tradition of men, but a command of our Savior. When we partake, we proclaim His death (1 Corinthians 11:26).

This was a practice of the early church. The church in the first century provides the pattern for our worship. In Acts 20:7 we read, "On the first day of the week, when we were gathered together to break bread, Paul talked with them." Their coming together on the first day of every week was not accidental, it was purposeful. The central act of their gathering was the breaking of bread, the Lord's Supper.

It serves as a weekly reminder of our salvation. Just as God set aside the first day of every week for Christians to assemble (Hebrews 10:25; 1 Corinthians 16:2), He also gave us the memorial of Christ's sacrifice to observe each week. We need frequent reminders of the price paid for our salvation. The weekly observance of the Supper keeps our hearts focused on the cross and our lives anchored in grace.

Every Sunday, Christians around the world share in this simple yet profound meal. It reminds us that we are one body (1 Corinthians 10:16–17). It calls us to examine ourselves (1 Corinthians 11:28) and to renew our commitment to the Lord who died for us.

The Lord's Supper is not a ritual to rush through or a tradition to take lightly. It is a weekly blessing, a time of remembrance, and a proclamation of the gospel. That is why we, like the early church, observe it every Lord's Day.
