Coming Soon: Art Exhibit: The exhibit *Cardboard Chronicles* will be displayed in the Fellowship Hall from **October 1 to November 13**. The exhibit will feature 25 original paintings by Rudolph Bostic that depict biblical stories painted on cardboard with enamel and house paint. Artist Rudolph Bostic is a longtime member of the Second African Baptist Church in Savannah, Georgia.
