
In today's gospel lesson Jesus reveals the reason why God has send him.

Holy Cross Day commemorates how Helena, the mother of the Roman Emperor Constantine, during a pilgrimage to Jerusalem in 325 A.D. found what she believed to be the cross on which Jesus died.

September 14, 335 A.D. was the day when a church built especially for the cross in Jerusalem was dedicated.

Numbers 21:4b-9 As the march through the desert takes longer and

longer people get rebellious against Moses and against God. When God sends poisonous snakes to bite them. When the people realize that they have sinned, Moses prays for them and God tells him to put up the image of a snake that will heal

all that look at it.

Psalm 78:1-2, 34-38 God reminds his people of their rebellion against

him, and how he was merciful.

1 Corinthians 1:18-24 Christ on the cross may seem weak, defeated

and foolish, but the wisdom of the world won't

save us - Jesus Christ will.

John 3:13-17 Just like the Israelites were saved from the snake

poison by looking at the serpent lifted up on the pole, so all who'll look at Jesus Christ lifted up on

the cross will be saved.

If you remove all the words listed below, the remaining first 30 letters reveal a phrase from Psalm 78:40 that describes what God's people did — and often still does!


