FLU SEASON IS HERE!

Don't forget your flu vaccination!

Flu is a contagious respiratory illness that infects the nose, throat, and sometimes the lung.

Here's the latest news about the flu vaccine:

- ACIP (Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices) recommends that children, pregnant women and all adults receive seasonal flu vaccines only in single-dose formulations that are free of thimerosal as a preservative.
- The US FDA made recommendations concerning the composition of 2025-2026 US flu vaccines.
- In September 2024 the FDA approved FLuMist, the live attenuated nasal spray flu vaccine, for self or caregiver administration.
- In March 2025, the FDA approved FLUblok, the recombinant (includes a gene or genes from the flu virus) flu vaccine, previously approved for people 18 years and older, for use in people 9 years and older (www.cdc.gov/flu)
