SMALL GROUP DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Proverbs 24:3–4 says homes are built “by wisdom.” What do you think that means in practical terms?
2. How do you see the difference between a house and a home?
3. Which of the three aspects—**faith, peace, or legacy**—do you think your home (or family of origin) reflected most? Which is hardest?
4. What does it look like for a home to be a “mission outpost” in your neighborhood?

For Families / Married Couples:

5. How can parents set the spiritual “temperature” of their home?
6. What daily or weekly rhythms could help your household grow in peace and faith?
7. What kind of legacy do you hope your kids (or future grandkids) will say you left behind?

For Singles / Young Adults:

8. What does it look like to create a “home of faith” even as a single person (apartment, dorm, shared housing)?
9. Who are the “spiritual children” or younger people you can influence toward Christ?
10. How can singles support families in the church as they seek to raise wise homes?

Closing Question (for all):

If someone walked into your home this week, what would they *feel*—and how could wisdom reshape that atmosphere?

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
