## **Communication Column**

I revisited the Communication Column from the last PSC update to get a reminder of what was said. It's hard to believe that a month ago, we were still anticipating the Reed family coming to TBC. The Wednesday night Bible study right now is in Joshua. Something from this week caught my ear. Why is the phrase "pass over" or "cross over" or similar used so much in chapters 3 and 4? They were literally crossing the Jordan, but that is also used to symbolize transition. It could be used to symbolize a transition to a new life in Christ, just like we do with baptism. I think it can also serve as a reminder that God is with us during transition and change. Sometimes change is in God's plan for our spiritual growth. It comforts me to know that God is with us always.

Another item of change is that TBC will be seeking a Music Minister. You'll see in the bulletin an announcement about voting on the proposed search committee for this process. It truly does come with great blessings to serve the church in this capacity.

So, how does this differ from a Pastor search committee? Well, to an extent, it is very similar. The nominating committee prayerfully sought to choose a search committee. It should be treated with the same reverence and sincerity. And our responsibility as a church is the same. We need to begin praying for the search committee that they will seek God's will in finding the right person to come. I can attest that those prayers are felt and needed to discern God's will.
