

# Hello from Bandung!

Thank you all for your continuous prayer. Every day I'm reminded of the awesome support I have thousands of miles away!

A week ago I wrapped up my homestay with an Indonesian family. There were some language barriers but nonetheless, on the first night, Bunda (mom) and I did karaoke together for maybe an hour. This was definitely an immersive experience! We talked about their family's Sundanese background, concerns about earthquakes, and love for movies and marathon biking, and much more. What we might see as adverse living is a home they are so willing to share. Experiencing hospitality through a different lense allowed me to truly appreciate Indonesian culture.

The last two weeks have included time at the orphanage, teaching English, and Bahasa Indonesia (language) tutoring. My team joined some University students in visiting the Curug Tilu Leuwi Opat waterfall, where we ended up dancing with some Ibu's (ladies).

An upcoming opportunity I'm especially excited about is working with a local handicraft business where mothers create handmade goods to earn income that supports their family.

This business needs help with online growth and gaining resale partners, so I'm eager to share some of my marketing background!

Prayer requests include peace and safety over Indonesia. I've also been praying that the difficulties in culture shock would lead to discovery not by ignoring them, but by experiencing them. Please pray for fruitful connections, as relationships are the roadmap to talking about Jesus.
