

#### Treasurer's Corner

For the September Tower we will once again be showing "directionally correct" numbers. The income is virtually locked in

because our 8/31 monies won't be deposited until September. The August expenses s/b close with only some of the salaries not landing until the 31st.

- Income is currently at \$12K out of a plan of \$13K (ironically, the same as last month)...just a bit soft, common for this time of the year.
- Expenses are currently at \$16K out of a plan of 19K. But remember, with several outstanding salaries this picture might change if they are all turned in by the 31st...if not, they will carryover into September.
- The year-end operational cash position is still projected above the \$30K level (easily seen in the chart below).



We were able to avoid having to tap into the Trustees' "stop-gap" apportionment funding for August, and we have completed the Conference Ministries section.

No Money Market transfers were required in August...aided by softer than planned expenses and income coming in relatively close to plan.

#### For the Capital Campaign:

• Since the construction loan is paid off, no further updates will be supplied unless the Trustees wish to highlight something.
