



Life Group Study Questions Acts 21:1-16

1. Read Acts 21:1-16 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Have you ever known that a difficult thing was coming up in your life? How did you handle knowing that? Did you try to avoid the painful thing? Why or why not?
3. How many times in our passage is Paul warned about going to Jerusalem? What is similar about each warning? How do they differ?
4. In verses 13-16 we see Paul's unflinching determination to go to Jerusalem. Was Paul being stubborn or reckless? How did he have such courage and boldness knowing what was coming?
5. Pastor Andrew's first point was "Be constrained by the Spirit". What does being led by the Spirit look like in your own life? How do you listen to him and obey? Read Galatians 5:16-25 and discuss walking in step with the Spirit.
6. Pastor Andrew's second point was "Treasure Christ above all things". What are ways you do this in your own life? What are some things you treasure above Jesus?
7. Pastor Andrew's third point was "Submit yourself to the will of God". How do you discern God's will in your life? How much does the Word of God factor into his leading in your life?
