But I believe as Christians we need to reclaim that word! It comes from a Greek root word: εύαγγελίζω or to use a more familiar alphabet... euaggelizó.


That word can be translated simply as "to share the Good News." As followers of a Risen Lord it is our job to share the Good News of Jesus Christ with this troubled world!
