In June, the El Paso UMC Board voted during the Ad Council meeting to give to a missionary that is the Coordinator of the Englishlanguage Program - Southeast Asia Methodist Mission, three Special Sunday Offerings - UMCOR Sunday, Peace with Justice Sunday and United Methodist Student Day Sunday, UMCOR United States Disaster Response & Recovery and East Bay Camp to fulfill the challenge of the Five Star Missions Challenge!



East Bay Camp & Retreat is located in Central Illinois on beautiful Lake Bloomington just 12 miles north of Bloomington-Normal at Hudson, IL, just a few minutes from Interstate 39.

East Bay offers space for re-creation of body and soul in a natural setting away from the routines and busy-ness of life. Attractive and functional facilities are great for groups gathering for renewal, team-building, fellowship, conferencing, and business.

With over 160 acres of woods, trails, and lake front, East Bay allows for delightful encounters with wildlife such as deer, wild turkeys, herons, turtles, and countless other creatures which make their home in its woods and lake. A variety of hardwoods and evergreens greet you as you walk through the property.

East Bay was founded in 1930 as a place set aside for children and adults alike to experience the wonder of God's creation, the mission of which continues today.

East Bay Camp is a vital ministry of the United Methodist Church, supported through the Illinois Great Rivers Conference. Because we are part of this connection, our church helps provide life-changing camp experiences for children, youth, and families across our region—offering a place where faith is nurtured, leaders are formed, and lives are transformed. Being United Methodist means we are part of something bigger than ourselves—a global connection that empowers ministry in ways no single church could do alone.

There will be multiple activities for kids and adults of all ages, including but not limited to, a Sky Diving performance by Skydive-Chicago, displays and demonstrations from local Law Enforcement, Fire, EMS, U.S. Army & Samp; Air National Guard, U.S. Marines & Samp; Navy Reserves, U.S. Coast Guard, Life Flight helicopter, Bi-Plane Air Show, 300' Zip-Line, a Barnyard Petting Zoo, our wildly popular 3rd Annual Hot Dog Eating Contest, and much more!
