SEASON OF CREATION

Adopted by General Synod in 2019, this is a time of prayer, education, and action. It is not a liturgical season but is instead a time of intentional prayer and reflection.

We join with the Earth and with each other


To celebrate the seas, to rejoice in the sunlight, to sing the song of the stars.
