Why Ministry Leaders Can't Ignore AI

Leaders can help congregants think about using AI through the lenses of Scripture, church teachings, and guidance from the Spirit. We should talk about how AI can assist as a brainstorming partner, how it offers great promise for science and medicine, AND how it raises serious ethical concerns, including its environmental impact and issues like plagiarism. Rio Texas Conference


North District
