General Assembly - Ruling Elder Commissioners and YAADS

The Nominating Committee will be accepting applications for ruling elder commissioners and YAADS until the end of this month (September 30th). If you know of someone in your congregation that would be interested, have them return the application as soon as possible to me. I will then forward it onto the Nominating Committee. The blank applications are attached.

Below is some information regarding the upcoming General Assembly.

General Assembly Theme

The theme of the 227th General Assembly (2026) is Persevering Toward Wholeness, and the guiding scripture is Revelation 22:2. "...and the leaves of the tree are for the healing of the nations." This theme will guide worship and resources throughout the assembly. You are invited to reflect on the theme in your own contexts as the assembly approaches.

Dates and Location

The 227th General Assembly (2026) docket will begin with committee meetings conducted online, followed by in-person plenary sessions held in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The format will be similar to that of the 226th General Assembly (2024), with a few tweaks:

- June 22 24: Assembly committee meetings, conducted online using Zoom and MyGA. Most commissioners and advisory delegates will participate remotely from their home, office, or another location with reliable internet service. Participation is required as a prerequisite to participating in plenary.
- June 25 & 26: Travel days for most commissioners and advisory delegates, with an orientation for YAADs on Friday, June 26.
- June 27: ALL NEW! Community Day, to include opportunities for public witness around the issue of gun
 violence; luncheons for assembly committee members; a Town Square with PC(USA) agencies and organizations
 available to equip attendees with resources and connections; and a welcome reception.
- June 28, morning: Worship and lunch with Milwaukee area congregations.
- June 28 July 2: Plenary business meetings, concluding with the election of the moderators on Thursday. These sessions are held in person at the Baird Center in downtown Milwaukee. Commissioners and advisory delegates must be present in person in the plenary hall to participate. There will not be an option for commissioners and advisory delegates to join the deliberations or vote remotely.

Standing Rule 3.A.3.a. specifies that "Commissioners and advisory delegates must plan to be in attendance for the duration of the General Assembly." This includes participation in their assigned assembly committee via Zoom and MyGA for all three days of its discernment, as well as the in-person meetings in Milwaukee. Please make sure that all those who are interested in serving are aware of the full schedule and can commit to participating online in all meetings of their assigned committee, traveling to Milwaukee, and staying for the duration of the plenary sessions. This includes all advisory delegates as well as commissioners.

Two documents - GA227 FAQs and GA227 What to Expect are available to provide potential commissioners and advisory delegates with more information about the General Assembly and the role of these participants in it, as well as the schedule and the time commitment. Please share these with all who are interested. Please also encourage them to consult the General Assembly web site regularly and to sign up for the *On the Road to GA* newsletter for more information. Worldwide Communion Sunday, October 5, 2025

We are excited to celebrate Worldwide Communion on Sunday, October 5th. This Sunday is set aside as a special day in which Christian communities around the world are invited and encouraged to celebrate communion. This helps to show our unity with each other in Jesus!

We invite you to consider participating in at least one of the following ways:



- Come to worship wearing traditional clothing from another part of our world or clothing that represents another part of our world (i.e. a sports jersey from your favorite international team). This will help us connect with our siblings in Christ.
- Choose to bake bread from a different country and bring it to share as part of our communion elements on the 5th. Please have your bread in the kitchen no later than 9:10 am on the 5th. Please sign up letting us know that you are bringing bread and what kind. The sign up is in the entry way.
- If you know another language, come prepared to share a greeting in that language. Additionally, if you know a worship song in another language, consider singing it as part of our worship.
- Help decorate our sanctuary for Worldwide Communion. If you have decorations from around the world, bring them in no later than Sunday, September 28th so that they may be used to decorate. You are welcome to join Pastor Mark in decorating our sanctuary on Thursday, October 2nd at 3 pm.





could also leave it in the kitchen after worship. If you are willing to help, please sign up on the sign-up page in the entry way or let Pastor Mark know.






