Opening Prayer & Scripture Reflection	Gospel Reading from Daily Office (Mark 12). Love of God is the foundation for everything else we do.	
Approval of Consent Agenda		Motion made, seconded and approved
Grant Updates:	*HGDPC: Grant of \$600K from NPS to repair church roof includes, enclosure study, engineering study, repairs to bell, etc. Vestry saved \$117k earmarked for Church roofnow available for other projects, HGDPC earmarked \$80k for Church roof project also now available for other projects. Grant Committee to seek and apply for matching grants to make these funds go further.  *A private donor recently gave \$30k.  *Rev. Chris will reapply for DIOPA grant. Last year's grant was total of \$8k distributed among Mission Committee, Roots Quarterly and Sexton Sideshow for Memorial Dei Picnic.  *Arts Grant from City of Phila for "O Brother" reduced from \$5k to \$3k. Request made to reduce difference by \$1k from monies received from last DIOPA grant.	
Property Updates and Plans	*Compression window enhancements to Rudman needed additional funds of \$1400 to purchase commercial grade product.  *Riverside Flooring: In light of recent grants and donations, the Vestry discussed replacing the full floor in Riverside hall, as well as removing the storage closets in the hall and replacing them with an exterior shed.  *Other discussions for future projects, i.e. walkway lighting along new entrance, paint and replace shutters in Rudman, restoring brick pathways in churchyard, ceiling repair in Church.	*Motion made, seconded and approved to provide additional funds of \$1400 to purchase commercial grade compression window enhancements to Rudman.  *Vestry agreed to move forward with replacing the Riverside floor with a commercial hardwood, and removing the storage closets. Cathy Ufheil will get flooring estimates and Mark Roberts will present options for a shed.  *Cathy Ufheil to get estimates for brick pathways; Amy to get written estimate for church ceiling.
