APPROVAL OF 2025 MINIMUM COMPENSATION & BENEFITS GUIDELINES

- Assistant to the Bishop Rev. Barb Streed was invited to discuss the process for creating this year's Guidelines. She also discussed some of the changes to this year's document compared to previous years regarding supporting information.
- The Minimum Compensation and Benefits Guidelines Task Force has been working on this document for several months and made the proposed document public on September 19. At this time, it was sent to all rostered leaders and congregational presidents of the SEMN Synod. It was open for public comment from September 20-September 30. No comments were received during this period.
- The Council was able to review this document prior to this meeting, along with a
